Grading

Players cannot be excluded from a team's grading process unless the players are wishing to join as groups of friends in a formed team.

Players should be graded on their football ability, football skill set, grading performance. Clubs internal grading policies should reflect these attributes.

Players wishing to join as a group of friends (formed team), the team must be graded into a suitable division based on the team's overall football skill only. The team shall not be permitted to join division 1 unless the following criteria has been satisfied:

1. The Association has positioned the team in Division 1 based on the team's performances and an assessment by the competition committee.
2. The team has been independently assessed.
3. A clubs appeal complete (with supporting information) has been approved by the competitions committee.

Borrowing

Where possible, clubs must only select players to be borrowed from the same age groups lower divisions. ie a 13/1s team should always look to borrow from the 13/2s.
